Samples Taken From Texaco's "Remediated" Sites

Of the 12 Texaco well sites inspected that the company claims to have remediated, 100% have levels of toxic contamination:

Well sites (in green) "remediated" by Texaco have high levels of toxics – was the clean-up a fraud?

*Ecuador decrees 1215 and 3516, which regulate environmental contamination in Ecuador.
